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

### Advance Buyer Credit (ABC) Loan Program

Great news from our friends at NIFA! Once again, they are looking out for the best interest of the first-time home buyers, and have introduced a new product, known as the Advance Buyer Credit (ABC) Loan Program. It is designed to help the first-time home buyer use the (now famous) \$8,000 tax credit for down payment and closing assistance with the purchase of a home. Under this new ABC Program, NIFA will allow the tax credit to be advanced to the homebuyer right at closing.

The program works with a combination of a first and second mortgage on the new home. For example, the first mortgage will be set up as a standard 30 year fixed FHA loan with no points, and a current interest rate of 6.25%. This interest rate can be improved upon by a reduction of .50% if the borrower pays off the second mortgage loan in full (details below) within 120 days after the loan closing date, and if the borrower is current on both the first and second mortgage loans. The .50% rate reduction would take effect with the fifth payment on the first mortgage as long as the second mortgage was paid off. The new lower rate would then remain as a fixed rate for the remaining term of the loan.

NIFA will then provide a second mortgage loan, at the same interest rate as the first mortgage rate (currently 6.25%). The second mortgage amount will be offered at up to 85% of the buyer's total tax credit, or \$6,800 maximum (85% of \$8,000), giving a total payment in this example of \$76.35. The loan proceeds from the second mortgage can only be used to pay for down payment, closing costs, and other prepaid expenses. The term offered is 120 months, and repayment will begin on the first day of the second mortgage must be paid in full within 120 days of the loan closing date in order to be eligible for the .50% rate reduction.



The only type of loan programs which allow this credit are FHA insured and RD guaranteed loans. The standard FHA and RD guidelines will apply. The second mortgage payment must also be included in the borrower's total housing expense ratio. In addition, all borrowers must contribute a minimum investment of \$1000 in the loan transaction. Under no circumstances will the borrowers be allowed to receive any cash back at closing. Lastly, to take advantage of NIFA's ABC Mortgage, all borrowers must complete a homebuyer education class prior to closing.

Hats off to NIFA for further opening the doors to home ownership by giving buyers a great down payment option when they need it most. Remember, your buyers must close on their new home no later than November 30, 2009. By working together with a NIFA approved lender, we can ensure no one misses out on this extraordinary opportunity. 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



### Safe Driving Is Important In Any Vehicle, But More Important In A Small Car

Smaller cars are popular right now, and they will be the wave of the future as the government increases mandatory gas mileage to 39 miles per gallon.

That's the average for cars made by any individual company. For specific cars, the mandatory mileage is 35.5. It won't happen until 2016.

Car makers already have or will soon have cars that meet or exceed the standard.

The Ford Fusion hybrid gets more than 40 mpg. The Chevy Cruise, due out in April 2010, will get 40 mpg, and the Chevy Volt, due out in November of this year, runs on batteries for the first 40 miles. Chrysler plans the Fiat SpA, which will be available by 2015 at 40 mpg or more.

Fuel costs are lower for a small car, but if you crash, your chances of getting hurt are greater. Here are a few driving tips to consider:

\* Be visible. Keep your lights on during the day. If you don't have automatic running lights, turn your headlights on and use the low beam.

\* Take extra care when entering an intersection



to assure that all vehicles from the other directions are cleared.

\* Avoid getting sandwiched between two trucks, two larger cars or two SUVs, especially when driving on the Interstate or a state highway.

\* On any roadway, it's more important for drivers of a smaller cars to use turn signals well ahead of where they will change lanes or turn.

\* Regardless of the size of your vehicle, practice thinking about how you could escape a dangerous situation. It could be a move to the shoulder, going off the road and avoiding trees, or maneuvering to another lane.

Rules of safe driving are more important when you are in a small car, including: Always wear a seat belt; don't drink and drive; watch for speed limit signs and don't exceed the posted numbers.

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### New Credit Card Protections Ban Some Extra Fees And Rate Fluctuations

The new credit card law requires that certain information be added to credit statements. A payment summary example:

- \* New balance \$1,000.
- \* Minimum payment \$35.
- \* Payment due date: 8/10/08. (Bills must be received 21 days before due.)
- \* Months before bill is paid off if only minimum payments are made: 49
- \* Interest amount if only minimum payments are made: \$827.75.

Other provisions include:

- \* Paying by phone: No fee can be charged for phone payments.
- \* Over-limit fees: They can't be charged unless the customer has agreed to allow them.
- \* Minors: For an under-21 consumer, the signature of a parent or other who will take re-

sponsibility for the debt, or give proof that the under-21 can pay.

\* Interest rate increases: There will be no retroactive interest-rate increases on existing balances unless payments are 60 days overdue. After that, a customer could get the old rate back by paying on time for six months.

To offset losses, card companies are expected to decrease rewards programs, raise some interest rates and charge an annual fee. The law takes effect in February of 2010.

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### Here's What's New In Bluetooth Headsets


There are a number of good Bluetooth headsets on the market, some for as little as \$20, but these are the favorites of Business Week's tech analyst, Stephen Wildstrom.

Aliph's Jawbone Prime (\$130). Its technique of using two microphones, one to pick up your voice, and one to detect ambient noise so it can be eliminated, has been widely copied by competitors. The new Jawbone Prime is still best for sending a clear voice from a noisy background.

The Prime comes in colors and can be worn without an earloop, if that works for you. Its multifunction buttons are easy to detect by feel.

BlueAnt's Q1 (\$130). This is unusual in that it responds to speech. When you turn the unit on, it can ask questions and respond to your answers.

The Q1 can handle most basic commands that you give it. The handy feature eliminates the problem of pressing the wrong button, which can lead to situations like hanging up in the middle of a conversation when you just wanted to increase the volume. Such embarrassing errors are eliminated with the speech recognition capability.

Plantronics Voyager PRO (\$100). The headset has an over-the-ear design, similar to those Voyager makes for desktop telephones. The design gives it room for a huge battery that lasts a long, long time.

Wildstrom claims that the PRO is a little ugly because it uses a mike boom that runs down your cheek. As geeky as it is, he says, it leads to both excellent voice quality and a minimum of wind noise. It is the leading choice if you often use your phone outdoors.

All three of these have multipoint pairing that lets you switch easily among multiple devices, such as a phone, laptop or hands-free kit for a car.



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### Smart Phones, GPS Systems, OS Changes Leap Forward

The first full week of June was a time of history-making changes in the cellphone business as smartphones made leaps forward in technology. The Palm Pre debuted on June 4. The Apple iPhone 3G S was unveiled on June 8.

The Palm Pre has an all-new operating system called webOS. It's a platform, like a PC, is designed to run a wide variety of sophisticated third-party programs, or apps, says The Wall Street Journal's Walter Mossberg. It runs everything from games to business tools, has a camera with a flash and it has Wi-Fi connectivity.

It now launches on the Sprint network, but will be offered by other carriers later. The Pre sells for \$200 after a \$100 mail-in rebate.

It has an elegant touch-screen interface, a real keyboard and can run various programs simultaneously.

The Apple iPhone 3G S can shoot and edit videos, has an upgraded camera, plus voice controls for making calls or playing music. Just ask out loud for a song or album and it plays. And the new Tom-Tom GPS now gives voice directions.

The S in the name stands for speed. USA Today's Edward Baig says it promises to be twice as fast as the original iPhone 3G and will render Web pages and launch applications twice as fast.

A model with 16 gigabytes costs \$199 with a two-year AT&Tcontrct. iPhone users can upgrade to the new system free of charge. iPod Touch users can upgrade for \$9.95.



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
