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

Rental Dwelling Insurance Can Minimize the Owners's Risk

For most people, rental dwelling ownership means a big investment with special risks. Buying a rental dwelling is a big undertaking and as an owner you need to make sure that you are adequately protecting your investment.

You'll want to make sure you have coverage for your property, your liability and loss of rents. The main components of rental dwelling insurance policy include: the dwelling, personal property, business liability and loss of rents.

Dwelling

Provides coverage for accidental loss to the building and other structures attached to it like a porch, garage or fence. If there are detached structures on the property, make sure to clearly define their use. If the structures are used for commercial, manufacturing, farming, or if your tenant decides to use them for any of these purposes or other business purposes, a standard rental dwelling policy may not cover losses arising from these activities.

Personal Property

Keep in mind, personal property includes items such as appliances, maintenance, and service equipment owned by you. If your rental dwelling policy does not

include this type of coverage, you might be exposed.

Business Liability

This important coverage insures you against bodily injury, personal injury, or property damage resulting from the ownership, use or maintenance of the property. These types of claims are the ones that could affect you and your family for a lifetime if you are not properly insured.

Business liability may also include coverage for the cost of legal defense.



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Mortgage Lending — Back to the Future

Remember the old days when borrowers were required to put 20 % down to purchase a home and mortgage loan professionals had a list of required documentation on the back of their business cards? Well, welcome back to the future.

Legislation and the tightening of the credit markets have in most cases replaced common sense underwriting and overall credit worthiness of a deal. Now, I don't want to be quoted saying our Underwriters don't use common sense, but anyone today who deals with either Fannie, Freddie or an investor is subject to the square hole, square peg mentality of lending. It requires a unique partnership between lenders and real estate professionals to help borrowers understand and navigate these regulatory and credit changes and requirements. Even the best of borrowers with FICO scores in the high seven hundreds are being required to bring paystubs, prior year W-2s and other supporting documentation to get loans funded.



One absolutely critical change is with Regulation Z which went into effect with applications taken on or after July 30, 2009. This regulation has significant impact on borrowers, realtors and mortgage bankers alike. The regulation states that a loan CANNOT close within seven business days from application REGARDLESS of the reason. This allows the potential borrower time to get his or her early disclosures, review them and possibly shop for more accommodating parameters.

If there are changes during the process in the loan that are APR (Annual Percent Rate) sensitive (which include loan amount, interest rate,) the prospective borrower has to be sent new disclosures and an additional 3 – 6 days has to be added onto the process depending on how the disclosures are delivered and received. A borrower can apply for a waiver, in their own handwriting but these will be limited to the same reasons for waiving a Right of Rescission period (ROR) which are very limited. Everyone in the process should note that specifically a contingent sale contract, pricing lock expiration date or moving arrangements are NOT considered emergencies.

These new regulations will require borrowers to be upfront with documentation immediately or risk not closing on time and losing out on a sale of a home. Those last minute Home Equity piggybacks will also not be an option, because these regulations apply to any consumer loan collateralized by a real estate property. The example here is borrowers that do not have required cash to close. Three Continued on Page 10

days before close, the loan amount is reduced on the first, no additional disclosures required because the original TIL (Truth in Lending), was overestimated and a piggy back second is secured by the home to make up for the difference in closing costs. The bank, any bank, would be required to wait an additional seven business days before they could close the second to make the deal work.

These changes will require Realtors and Mortgage Loan Professionals to work very closely together making sure that the borrowers understand any delays in the process may not be recoverable.

The difference today is that experienced underwriters and a professional processing staff can make the critical discoveries early in the process so necessary disclosures can be completed and the borrowers clearly understand the product. KeyBox Holds 2 – 3VG Lithium Maganese Dioxide batteries, with approximately a 6 year battery life. Each time you release the shackle on the iBox your key displays the battery percentage left.

Example: KeyBox Battery 76%

When the KeyBox battery is 5% or less bring the iBox into the OABR office and we will exchange the iBox at no cost to the agent.

Key Container

- Holds 3 Keys
- Attach Keys with provided chain, or leave keys loose. **DO NOT** use paper clips, rings, rubber bands, ID tags in the key container. Be sure you have a spare set of keys before you close the key container.

iBox Capability

- Stores the last 100 accesses
- Recorded entries include agent identification and date and time of entry
- Can program iBoxes for specific access times: Weekdays (Mon-Fri), Saturday, and Sunday
- Call Before Showing or CBS Code is a special code which can be activated on the iBox which limits access to anyone wanting to open the KeyBox. If the CBS Code is activated contact the Isiting agent for the special code to access the iBox. If you use this feature it's always a good idea to list in agent remarks, 'CBS Code Activated on KeyBox, must call for Code.'
- Programmable shackle codes, you can change the shackle code of each iBox. If you have the
 white and blue ActiveKey you would need to bring the iBox into the OABR office to change the
 shackle code. If you have a Smart Phone eKey you can change the shackle code yourself.


