Knowledge is Power: Standing Room Only!

The room was packed as over 100 agents were in attendance for Gregg Mitchell's Market Overview KIP seminar held March 20th. This has become an annual event and consistently draws a large crowd.

Gregg reported that the last 12 quarters ending in December 2013 showed a consistent growth trend where every quarter's closed sales volume out performed the same quarter the previous year. Gregg agreed with the Kiplinger Report stating that this year's real estate market has a very positive outlook with listing inventory being the one part of the equation that may keep us from having another outstanding year. Regarding appreciation and appraisals, it's a seller's market now in full force and multiple offers once again are being experienced, so appreciation will again be a homeowner's best friend. When asked how to deal with low appraisals, Gregg suggested doing your homework before the appraiser unlocks the front door. If you tested the "upper end" of the market and received top dollar, you should leave a package for the appraiser at the home with comparables used and note any positives or negative influencing factors that you know about a comparable the appraiser may not know. Providing an appraiser with this information before hand can be a very helpful tool.



Flood Insurance... Is Your Transaction Sinking?

On March 28th, Robert Scudder with Fidelity National Insurance Flood Division brought us up-to-date on recent changes to the Biggert-Waters Flood Bill of 2012. Congress recently passed amendments to ease the process of increasing flood policy premiums to full actuarial rates. Nationally, the implementation of the 2012 Bill has adversely affected the sale of homes located in flood zones due to the requirement to immediately risk-rate properties at full actuarial rates when a property transfer or sale occurs. Additionally, premiums were being increased on existing policies at 25% annually until fully risk-rated. While the recent amendments to the 2012 Bill have not yet been signed into law and implemented, the changes would now allow existing subsidized policies to transfer to the new property owner. Current premiums would increase by 18% (rather than 25% previously) on residential properties. Secondary homes, rental and commercial properties will still be increased at 25% until fully risk rated.

The National Flood Insurance Program operated by FEMA has previously subsidized premiums for property owners in flood zones keeping them artificially low and affordable. Due to Hurricanes Katrina, Sandy and the excessive flooding in 2011, the program is 26 Billion dollars in debt and Congress determined the only way it could continue is to bring flood policy premiums to full actuarial rates which in many cases are exponentially higher than the subsidized premiums of the past.





Eastern Subterranean Termites in Nebraska

As Spring has sprung so have many pests including termites. Termites are active all across the state of Nebraska. In our region of the country Eastern Subterranean Termites are known to cause the most damage. It is the most common termite in the USA. There are other types of termites such as the Drywood termites which are not native to the state and the Formosan Termites, which live in very warm locations in the Southern states. The Subterranean termite swarms during the day from March to May, usually on a warm day after it has rained occasionally a few smaller swarms may occur during the summer. Southeastern Nebraska is located in TIP ZONE #2, which is moderate to heavy (TIP=Termite Infestation Probability Zone) meaning the potential for termite damage is great. The Northeastern part of the state is located in TIP ZONE #3, which is slight to moderate meaning there is some potential for damage. The Eastern subterranean termite causes millions of dollars of damage. It is estimated that more than 1in 5 homes in the high activity areas have or will be attacked at some time.



Within the termite nest lives the queen, king, the winged reproductive (young kings & queens) soldier and worker termites. They all work together for the survival of the colony. The queen can live more than 25 years and produce more than 2,000 eggs a day. The workers cause the damage and carry out all the work in the nest. The



soldiers defend the colony usually against ants and are the first to be seen in large numbers when mud shelter tubes or damaged timber are opened. The swarmers are seen when they swarm during daylight, they drop their wings finding a mate to become king & queen of a new termite colony.

The colony nests are usually located in the ground below the frost line, but above the water table. Shelter tubes are constructed across hard objects in order gain access to timber food sources. Termites are constantly looking for new food sources. They can enter buildings through small cracks and are looking for an area where moisture collects inside the wall cavity from leaking pipes, faulty plumbing, guttering or broken roof tiles. Termites travel in mud shelter tubes for protection.

If you find eastern subterranean termites in or around your property DO NOT disturb them and arrange for a professional inspection and treatment application. There are several ways to treat termites such as chemical soil treatment or termite bating depending on the infestation. A professional termite inspection and treatments costs vary depending on the size of the house, style of construction and ease of inspection areas.

When having an inspection conducted on your property your inspector will need access to the full interior and exterior of the house, garage, and any outbuildings. Every pest control service is not the same. Pricing and warranties vary from company to company. Modern technology products are safer but more expensive and require a higher level of skills to ensure an effective result.

Why am I Getting a Showing Notification for Someone Else's Listing?



The Supra system is sometimes too smart. 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Know the Code

Article 13

REALTORS[®] shall not engage in activities that constitute the unauthorized practice of law and shall recommend that legal counsel be obtained when the interest of any party to the transaction requires it.

Article 14

If charged with unethical practice or asked to present evidence or to cooperate in any other way, in any professional standards proceeding or investigation, REALTORS[®] shall place all pertinent facts before the proper tribunals of the Member Board or affiliated institute,

society, or council in which membership is held and shall take no action to disrupt or obstruct such processes. (Amended 1/99)

• Standard of Practice 14-1

REALTORS[®] shall not be subject to disciplinary proceedings in more than one Board of REALTORS[®] or affiliated institute, society or council in which they hold membership with respect to alleged violations of the Code of Ethics relating to the same transaction or event. (Amended 1/95)

• Standard of Practice 14-2

REALTORS® shall not make any unauthorized disclosure or



dissemination of the allegations, findings, or decision developed in connection with an ethics hearing or appeal or in connection with an arbitration hearing or procedural review. (Amended 1/92)

• Standard of Practice 14-3

REALTORS[®] shall not obstruct the Board's investigative or professional standards proceedings by instituting or threatening to institute actions for libel, slander or defamation against any party to a professional standards proceeding or their witnesses based on the filing of an arbitration request, an ethics complaint, or testimony given before any tribunal. (Adopted 11/87, Amended 1/99)

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What are the qualifications of competent home inspector? What type of background and training is essential for an inspector?

Like any professional occupation, a qualified inspector brings a wealth of information to the inspection. Your buyer is depending on clear objective information to make that final decision on the purchase of the home they chosen. Therefore, a background in building or construction is virtually essential, focusing the eyes and ears to recognize when aspects of a home are out of balance – sometimes literally out-of-balance in the case of structure stability.



The Value of Certification

To be connected to and recognized by other professionals in one's industry is also important. We acknowledge professionals by their experience and credentials with elite associations. For home inspectors that organization is the American Society of Home Inspectors (ASHI).

To begin with, an inspector can become a member of ASHI, which includes monthly educational meetings and participating in ongoing education. All ASHI members must complete 20 hours of continuing education each year.

The qualifying credential that all ASHI members seek is called "Certified Inspector." This is a good time to recognize Jon Vacha, our newest inspector who just received this designation. Jon had to pass several professional -level exams (4-6 hrs) at an independent testing location. In the last two years Jon also completed 250 fee paid inspections, 40 of which are examined by ASHI to verify they met (or exceeded) the ASHI Standards and Practices and are competently completed. Finally he completed his continuing education and is a member in good standing.

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It was a long haul, and you did it, Jon!

In addition to these requirements, an inspector must be able to communicate well. An inspector must be able to inspect a home in 2.5 - 5 hours and be able to create a computer-generated report that objectively summarizes the condition of that home for buyers who often are not knowledgeable of construction terms and methods.

It is an art to be able to communicate a house full of information in a 30-40 minute presentation. Interestingly Tim Krof and Jon Vacha both have accounting experience and degrees. They were trained to recognize details and formulate results. This education and construction experience enables them to recognize the pertinent details and summarize them into a well-crafted inspection report.

In short, this ability to recognize issues, put them into perspective to the home and its age, communicate them to the buyer, and create a report that is clear for others not at the inspection is the goal of the inspector.
