The Board reviewed market activity and statistics.

President Archer thanked all who participated in REcharge 2023. The event was a huge success. At REcharge, the OABR Membership voted and approved the merger between Omaha Area Board of REALTORS® and Fremont Board of REALTORS®.

GPRMLS

GPRMLS LLC Director Anderson reported the Board of Directors reviewed and denied a request to waive a fine from a violation of the MLS Rules. The Board of Directors were updated on the GPRMLS Uniform Purchase Agreement and given an MLS staffing update.





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Foundation

Foundation President Bengtson reported the Foundation Directors reviewed their Strategic Plan and mission. The Foundation approved a process for reviewing charitable funding requests and agreed that cash disbursements are limited to 75 percent of the new funds collected for the fiscal year, however, the Board of Directors has the authority to manage all funds and determine the timing and amount of all payments.

The vote will take place from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 15, 2023, in the front foyer of the La Vista Convention Center, 12520 Westport Pkwy, La Vista, NE 68128. REALTOR® members may also vote early at the OABR Office, 11830 Nicholas Street, Omaha, NE 68154, on Tuesday, February 14, 2023, from 8:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.

A quorum attended the meeting. A total of 59 OABR REALTOR® members voted. The vote was unanimous in approving the merger of the Fremont Board of REALTORS® and the Omaha Area Board of REALTORS®. No opposition was noted.
